Dear Friend:

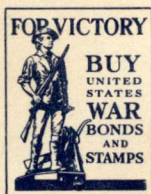

This man is a persistent gambler and a drinker and it did not take me long to get rid of him, but his attitude is bad. He has a kind of a sneaking attitude. It will be well to keep your eyes on him in regards to gambling and liquor.

We are getting along pretty good here and hope you are doing the same. I am trying to hire a man here by the name of Carl Adams and the only position I have open is a \$2,600 position. This man would make a good Associate Internal Security Chief at \$3,200. In case I am able to hire him in the position I have for him, any time you need him, I will be only too glad to transfer him to your office with advancement. J. B. Cook knows this man.

I soon hope to have my Caucasian Policemen at full strength so we can take over when the Army decides to move out.

By the way, I did not receive the geese you were going to send me last winter. Give my regards


