Dear Rev. Miller —
We have been on the train for
one day, having left Santa Anita
at 9:30 A.M. yesterday.
The train has just stopped at
Melford, Utah. The engine is taking
a supply of water. The land
is a vast, dry plain of sage brush.
Mountains in the distance.

Food served on train is wonderful.
Yesterday we had roast beef, string beans,
salad (lettuce, tomatoes), milk, rolls, butter,
& pudding for dinner. For supper
we had chicken a la king, peas, salad,
rolls, butter, coffee, & ice cream. This
morning we had bacon, scrambled
eggs, rolls, butter, & coffee. Meals
are deliciously prepared, courteously
served. — Sleeping quarters slightly
cramped, however. Several of us
slept in the baggage room on top of
the suitcases. I slept like a log.
May be I shall change over to a hard
bed. There are 18 cars on this train.
— includes 3 baggage, 2 liners, 2 pullmans
for the aged & sick. Whole train is pullman
but the healthy ones not allowed to use
the upper berths — hence the congestion
