about 500 on a trip. This will continue
up to and including September 15. The

Valley, Hollywood, and small groups picked here and there.

Then from September 17 to 27 will be the movements to Granada Colorado.

This group consists of the so-called "Westside" and the Vermont bunch of L. A. Incidentally our family received notice yesterday that we are to move on Monday September 21.

On September 20, the movements to Arkansas will begin and will continue up to October 16. That is to say that the first four movements for Arkansas will be sandwiched between the Colorado group. I do not know how this group is divided, but there are a lot of L. A. people included.

Although I am uninformed as to when this movement begins, the last one will be to Gila Arizona. Included in this group will be L. A., Long Beach, and vicinity.

I should like to give descriptions of all these camps but will wait until there is more information. Sincerely, George Yshioka
