Hi love. See that they chopped your letter down to nuttin' in the P.C., but you got ^{my} revenge through the Tozai Times (July, 1988)!

Mike's fighting back (see enclosure), but the letter'll give you a good laugh. It's obvious he hasn't read the final government report on the CWRIC hearings, PERSONAL JUSTICE DENIED. Pages 101-102, 154, 157, 178, all highly incriminating. Then he hangs himself with his own MOSES: "Cooperation would be our contribution to the war effort and proof of the Americanism of the Japanese American;" (p. 156); then "If identical circumstances should arise tomorrow... chances are that I would urge the same acceptance of patriotic duty." (p. 158) Uyeda told me last night that The Nisei Lobby is comprised of one member--Mike. The Nisei Vet. Assn has a total of five.

Am waiting patiently for the JAACL stuff. P. 335 of GREAT BETRAYAL says Kuroki was vet of 58 missions in Europe. Love to you and Dana.
