Dear Michi,



We attended the 552-Dachau survivors reunion. Over 400 people attended and it was a moving experience. Couple ex-black soldiers (one a minister) attended and told the crowd that only the blacks were assigned to move the bodies and the diseased survivors. As a result many black soldiers contracted the disease and died.

In the coming weeks we can expect more Japan-bashing by Congress, but perhaps we Nisei "may" not get it on the chin thanks to the positive publicity we received on Pearl Harbor Day!! Who knows.
