OCCUPANCY PERMIT AND WORK AGREEMENT

I THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, HEREINAFTER CALLED THE "GOVERNMENT", DOES HEREBY, SUBJECT TO THE CONDITIONS HEREINAFTER SET FORTH, GRANT TO George Nashara, NO.            AT THE            CAMP, AND TO PARTICIPATE IN THE COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES MAINTAINED IN CONNECTION WITH THE CAMP. Ontario-Payette, Idaho

II IT IS UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED THAT THE PRIVILEGE HEREBY GRANTED INCLUDING ONLY THE AUTHORITY TO USE THE ABOVE-DESCRIBED PREMISES FOR RESIDENTIAL PURPOSE OF THE CAMPER AND HIS IMMEDIATE FAMILY, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUCH RULES AND REGULATIONS AS ARE PROMULGATED FOR THE CAMP PROJECT BY THE GOVERNMENT, THE CAMP MANAGER AND THE CAMP COUNCIL, AND THAT IT DOES NOT AUTHORIZE THE ERECTION OF ANY STRUCTURES OF ANY KIND WHATSOEVER, WITHOUT THE WRITTEN CONSENT OF THE CAMP MANAGER. IT IS FURTHER UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED THAT THIS PERMIT SHALL NOT BE ASSIGNED BY THE CAMPER, AND THAT THE GOVERNMENT, AT ITS OPTION, MAY REVOKE SAID PERMIT AND THE PRIVILEGE GRANTED THEREBY AT ANY TIME, BY GIVING THREE (3) DAYS' WRITTEN NOTICE DELIVERED OR ADDRESSED TO THE CAMPER AT HIS ABOVE-DESIGNATED PLACE OF RESIDENCE. IMMEDIATELY UPON THE EXPIRATION OF SUCH NOTICE, THE CAMPER SHALL QUIETLY AND PEACEABLY REMOVE FROM THE PREMISES AND SURRENDER POSSESSION THEREOF, AND THE GOVERNMENT MAY IMMEDIATELY OR AT ANY TIME AFTER THE EXPIRATION OF SUCH NOTICE REENTER AND TAKE POSSESSION OF THE PREMISES AND REMOVE ALL PERSONS AND PROPERTY THEREFROM, BY SUMMARY DISPOSSESS PROCEEDINGS, OR BY SUITABLE ACTION OR PROCEEDINGS AT LAW OR EQUITY.

III IT IS UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED THAT THE CAMPER OR A MEMBER OF HIS FAMILY DEEMED QUALIFIED BY THE OFFICIAL IN CHARGE OF THE PROJECT WILL PERFORM, WHILE IN OCCUPANCY AT THE CAMP, ALL THE FOLLOWING REQUIRED WORK IN A GOOD AND WORKMANLIKE MANNER.

IT IS FURTHER UNDERSTOOD THAT:

- 1 IF THE REQUIRED WORK IS NOT PERFORMED IN A SATISFACTORY MANNER, AS DETERMINED BY THE OFFICER IN CHARGE OF THE PROJECT, THE CAMPER MAY BE REMOVED AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH NUMBERED II HEREINABOVE.
- 2 THE REQUIRED WORK IS TO BE PERFORMED UNDER THE DIRECTION AND SUPERVISION OF THE OFFICER IN CHARGE OF THE PROJECT, AND CONSISTENT WITH GOOD ADMINISTRATION, AT SUCH TIMES AS ARE MOST CONVENIENT TO THE CAMPER AND TO SUCH MEMBERS OF HIS FAMILY AS ARE DEEMED QUALIFIED BY THE OFFICER IN CHARGE OF THE PROJECT TO DO THE WORK.
- 3 THE REQUIRED WORK WILL BE PERFORMED ONLY BY THE UNDERSIGNED CAMPER, HIMSELF, OR BY MEMBERS OF HIS FAMILY DEEMED QUALIFIED BY THE OFFICER IN CHARGE OF THE PROJECT TO DO THE WORK, AND BY NO OTHER PERSON.
- 4 SHOULD THE CAMPER DESIRE TO EXCHANGE LABOR REQUIRED HEREUNDER WITH ONE OR MORE OTHER CAMPERS, HE WILL SO NOTIFY THE OFFICER IN CHARGE OF THE PROJECT WHO WILL, IF HE APPROVES, AMEND THIS AGREEMENT ACCORDINGLY.
- 5 THE CAMPER, AND THE MEMBERS OF HIS FAMILY DEEMED QUALIFIED BY THE OFFICER IN CHARGE OF THE PROJECT TO PERFORM THE REQUIRED WORK, SHALL BE ENTITLED TO RECEIVE THE COMPENSATION BENEFITS AUTHORIZED BY FEDERAL LAW IN CONNECTION WITH THE PERFORMANCE OF SUCH WORK.
