How do you do? I am fine as usual. I hope you are all in good of health. I am sorry I didn't write to you for quite a long time. Please excuse me for not writing.

The weather over here is getting pretty cool. I hear the temperature in Los Angeles went up to 105° . I remember that the time when it went up to 106° or 107° in 1939 I believe. Was it hot, I just couldn't stand it.

There is story that all of us Japanese could return to California and the West Coast. There are few Japanese already return to coast. They are mostly half breed or wife of caucasian. There is one girl attending Pasadena J.C. you might of read that in newspaper. Do you think we could return to Sawndale and farm all over again? Will it very hard for us to start a new farm because we haven't the tool and machinery and the money. I believe most of us must be a laborers again. By the way how are doing with our farm? Is the Chinese still operating it? I hope they are growing a good crop. Do you remember the time of ~~evacuation~~ evacuation,

when a fellow and I took our trunk to your garage for storage, that we ask you to sent to us at Santa Anita. The fellow that help me is now going into the Army. His brother who is now station at Fresno was here for visits for few days. He was down to Los Angeles on a pass. I believe he was went to Fawndale and Gardena how his property is. His name is Sgt. Yukio Jasmuro. I should of told him to visits you if I did know him going to Los Angeles.

Are you still working at the Dairy. Arent they short of help nowdays with everybody going to factory, where it paye more. If you could buy a film at Fawndale or Hawthorne will you takes a picture of our place and yours. I like to see how it look at two and half years. I am trying to get a film to sent to you so you could take picture. I will pay for the film and developing if you could get any. I think I better close for to day Goodbye
