ADMINISTRATIVE NOTICE NO. 23

August 11, 1942

Subject: Registration of Evacuees' Rentable Property

On orders from our San Francisco office, it will be necessary for all Japanese evacuees whose property is not handled by an agent, to immediately register such property.

The following directive should be strictly adhered to:

1. If you have rentable property, rented or offered for rent in any one of the defense-rental areas, it must be registered either by you or your agent. If you have an agent, be certain he has filed your property. If you personally are handling the renting of your own property, it will be necessary for you to obtain and fill out the regular registration form.
2. You can obtain registration forms by applying to your nearest information office. Requests should be made not later than August 15, 1942.
3. The rent law covers all types of dwelling units, but not commercial structures unless any portion is used for dwelling accommodations. Nor does it include farm lands or any dwellings thereon which are customarily used in farm operations. If, however, a structure exists on a farm and it, or any part of it, is rented solely for purposes of residence, it must be so registered.
4. If you are in doubt as to whether your property is located in one of the defense-rental areas, be on the safe side and register the property in any event.
