Dear Recipient:

We have completed our review of the documents that you recently sent to us. Based on our review we have determined that you are eligible to receive a redress payment of \$20,000.00.

We do not know the exact date your payment will be sent. We expect that payments will begin shortly after October 1, 1990, with the mailing of the first 25,000 checks. The second round of payments will probably begin in October 1991, at which time an additional 25,000 checks will be distributed. Payments will begin in order of age beginning with the oldest recipients.
