Thank you for your letter of July 12, 1989, containing your comments discussing your unique situation during World War II. The proposed regulations for the redress provisions for the Civil Liberties Act of 1988, were published for public comments, such as yours.

We are currently reviewing all written correspondence received during the comment period. Your statements regarding the ineligibility of children born outside the internment camp in non-restricted areas is being considered in light of the Act's language and Congress's intent. We presently anticipate that the final regulations will be published in the Federal Register at a later date this summer.
