"THE JAPANESE AMERICAN LEGACY"

A SYMPOSIUM

It has been 53 years since President Roosevelt signed Executive Order No. 9066, which removed 120,000 persons of Japanese ancestry from the west coast during World War II.

This action was taken without charges or trial, simply because of the ancestry of the evacuees. It has been generally agreed that "The Evacuation" is the most flagrant abrogation of civil rights on record in this country.

In the half century since 1942, Japanese Americans have raised themselves by their bootstraps and have made a remarkable recovery into the mainstream of American life.

Today, we have assembled an outstanding panel of Nisei and Sansei leaders to assess the status of Japanese Americans today, and to recall the difficult paths that many Nikkei were forced to travel in order to survive the devastating removal from homes, farms and businesses. We may also come up with some observations as to what the future holds for us, "The Japanese Americans."

MODERATOR:

Wayne Maeda

He helped develop a course called "Asian American Experience" in 1970 and began teaching at California State University at Sacramento in 1971.

On the 50th anniversary of the evacuation of all Japanese Americans from the West Coast, he designed and installed a major historical exhibit for the Sacramento History Museum entitled "Japanese Americans: Story of a People."

Carole Hayashino

Sansei community leader, former Acting Director National JACL.

Fred Korematsu

Challenged the U.S. Government's order that removed 120,000 Japanese Americans from the west coast.

William M. Marutani

1975-1986 Judge, Court of Common Pleas, Pennsylvania. Only Nikkei on President's Committee on Evacuation and Redress.

Dale Minami

Doctor of Jurisprudence from University of California School of Law. Lead attorney in coram nobis court action which overturned the conviction of Fred Korematsu.

Priscilla Ouchida

As key aide to then Assemblyman Patrick Johnston, she was architect and motivation behind several pieces of legislation which protected redress and reparation payments from State of California income tax.

Mary Tsukamoto

Educator, activist and author. She has been instrumental in the education of thousands of Californians about the story of the Japanese Americans and the evacuation.

Dr. Clifford Uyeda

JACL National Redress Chair, President National JACL 1978–1980, President National Japanese American Historical Society 1988–1994.



WILLIAM M. MARUTANI

Bill Marutani, as a young internee in Tulelake in the summer of 1942, worked as a live-wire reporter on the Tulean Dispatch.

After completing his schooling, he put up his shingle as an attorney in Philadelphia. From 1975 to 1986 he served as Judge, Court of Common Pleas, First Judicial District, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

In 1967, on behalf of *amicus* Japanese American Citizens League presented oral argument before U.S. Supreme Court in *Loving v. Virginia*, striking down anti-miscegenation laws in 16 states.

Ij 1981, he was appointed by the President to the ""Commission on Wartime Relocation and Internment of Civilians," which investigated the causes of the uprooting and confinement during World War II of 115,000 Japanese Americans and their parents residing in Washington, Oregon and California. Submitted findings, with recommendations, to the Congress and President.

He is now back in private practice in Philadelphia.



IRENE Y. HIRANO

Executive Director and President Japanese American National Museum

Since 1988, Irene Y. Hirano has been the Executive Director and President of the Japanese American National Museum. Under Ms. Hirano's guidance, the Museum reached its Phase I goal of raising \$13 million to renovate its historic headquarters in Los Angeles' Little Tokyo and to open the Museum to the public in 1992.

Ms. Hirano is now leading the way as the Museum embarks on its Phase II campaign to construct an 80,000 square-foot expansion pavilion, created long term exhibitions and programs and build an endowment fund for the future operations and programs. Drawings for the pavilion have been drawn up by the internationally-known firm, Hellmuth, Obata and Kassabaum and research has already begun on the core exhibitions.

Having earned a bachelor of science and masters degree in public administration from the University of Southern California, Ms. Hirano has served on numerous state and national boards and commissions. Appointed by President William Clinton in 1994, she is currently a member of the President's Commission on the Future. She is at the Board of the Los Angeles Educational Alliance for Restructuring Now (LEARN) and Marlborough School. She has served on the Boards of Leadership Education for Asian Pacifics (LEAP), Liberty Hill Foundation, California Commission on the Status of Women and the National Network of Asian and Pacific Women.
