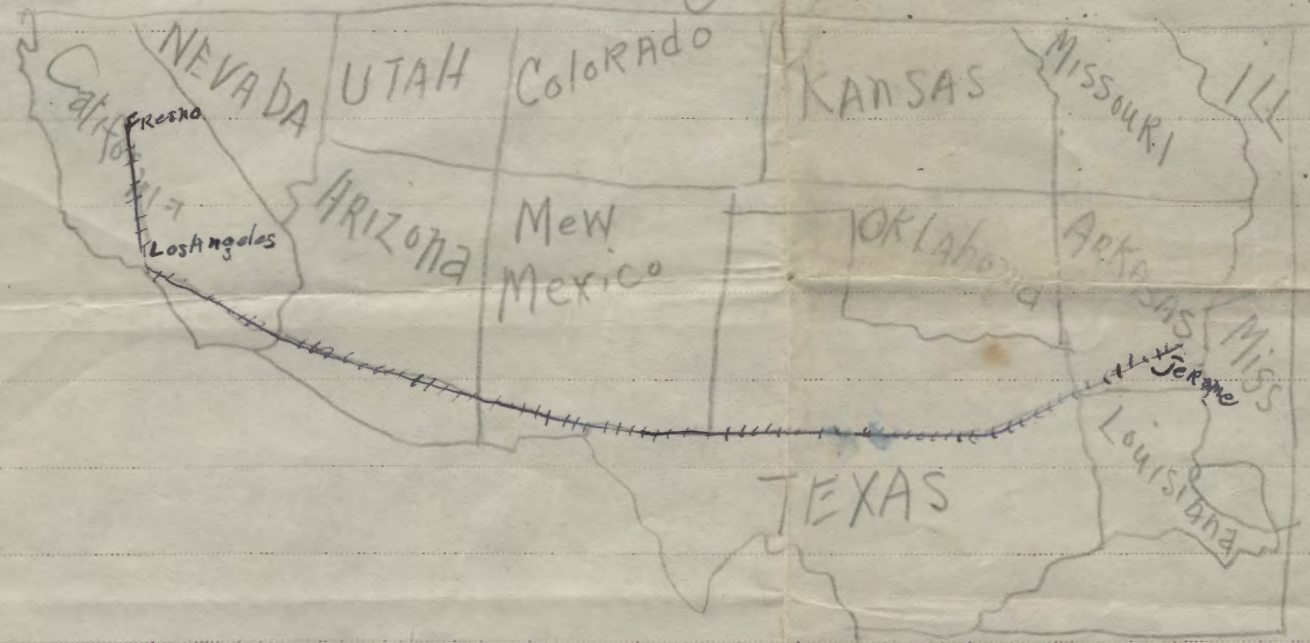
I have asked Ross for my sewing machine, but they
