SUMMARY OF CURRENT JOB OFFER SITUATION . .

Reduction in employment in some of the major war plants in the Twin Cities has lessened the demand for help somewhat in this area, but we are experiencing no difficulty in finding employment for resettlers here and are assured by the War Manpower Commission representatives that we need expect no difficulty in the near future. The variety of jobs is somewhat curtailed and the finding of proper jobs is now requiring more effort on the part of both the resettler and the Relocation Officer.

## SUMMARY OF CURRENT HOUSING SITUATION

The opening of the Twin City Lutheran Relocation Hostel in Minneapolis has been of great help to new arrivals in the Twin Cities, and it has removed for many people the burden of finding temporary housing. The finding of permanent housing is still difficult, although it is not proving impossible.
