

As foretold in our Job Summary Report for the North Central Area (Chicago) for April 1, farm offers make up the most noticeable additions in the attached seventh Job Summary Report, listing additions to and deletions from the complete listing sent two weeks ago. Emphasis should be laid on the fact that in this and all other Job Summary Reports no attempt is made to list individual openings in most classifications and one entry such as, auto mechanics or greenhouse workers may represent many jobs falling within these general classifications. Literally, thousands of positions are open in the North Central Area for both issei and nisei, and a wide selection of jobs is available to most individuals arriving in the various district offices.

The Peoria district office reports no change in their employment situation since the report of April 1, and those changes which have occurred in the Chicago, Rockford, Milwaukee, and Minneapolis district offices are given in detail in the attached pages. The Indianapolis Job Summary Report is repeated in full with the additional information as to the location of each job.
