Several new types of job offers have been added to the usual ones. More satisfactory placements can be made when applicants come out on a general invitation rather than on specific offers, except for those persons who have had special training.

Employment opportunities in this district are open to the Issei on an equal basis with all other resettlers with the exception of Civil Service positions, which must be filled by citizens.

SUMMARY OF CURRENT HOUSING SITUATION :

Unfurnished apartments are available to resettlers through the War Housing Center. Furnished rooms for single persons present little difficulty, but furnished apartments for families require time, patience, and footwork.
