

1. HOUSING.

- (a) Living quarters must be kept clean and sanitary at all times. Inspection of each apartment will be made at regular intervals.
- (b) FAMILIES OR SINGLE PERSONS MUST NOT MOVE FROM BARRACKS WITHOUT WRITTEN PERMISSION FROM THE LODGING SUP'T.

2. MESS

- (a) Enter all Mess Halls at center entrances only. Leave by the end exits.
- (b) Under no conditions are dishes, silverware, linen, dish-towels, aprons, food, milk bottles or cups to be taken out of Mess Hall.
- (c) All food will be served from the counters and carried direct to the tables. Upon leaving the table pick up your dishes and place them in trays at the exits. Deposit all silverware in the baskets placed to receive same.
- (d) Careful handling of all dishes is necessary to avoid breakage.
- (e) Admission to the kitchen is restricted to kitchen personal or Managerial staff concerned with inspection.

3. HEALTH.

- (a) All persons inducted in camp must be vaccinated and inoculated the day following arrival. Each individual will report to the Hospital at the hour designated on Information Bulliten.
- (b) Mothers with babies under twelve (12) months of age shall report to the Hospital between the hours of 8 A.M. to 9 A.M. or 4 P.M. to 5 P.M. on the first day of arrival. This is necessary for the purpose of registry and proper feeding instructions.
- (c) All persons requiring medical attention or special diets, must register at the Hospital for examination.
- (d) Accident or sickness must be reported to the Hospital at once.

4. WORK ASSIGNMENTS.

- (a) All persons male or female, receiving work orders, must report to the location and person at the date and hour indicated on assignment document.
