This is to advise you that it was deemed inadvisable to post the notice which you brought to this office requesting persons to be prepared to submit evidence on behalf of Mr. Saijo, Saturday afternoon. We do not wish to cause any unnecessary worry or discontent at the Poultry Project as we feel that workers as individuals are not involved in this matter.

Please be advised that this office will arrange to have evidence presented stating the reasons for this termination. It is impossible at this time to give names of individuals who will be on hand to substantiate the reasons for termination but we will do the best we can to present the facts as we have been able to ascertain them. This evidence will be ready for presentation at your hearing Saturday, May 6 at 1:30 p.m.
