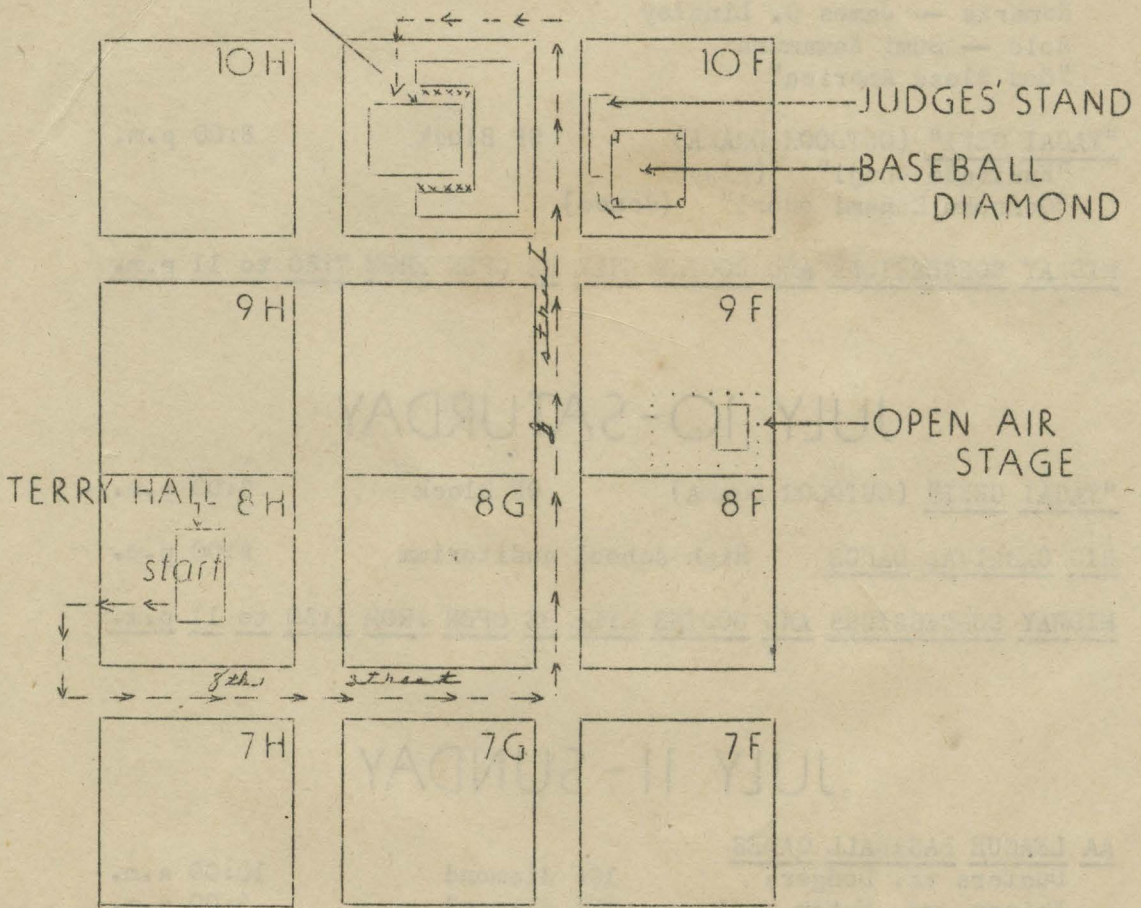


## BLUE STAR MOTHERS WAR SAVINGS STAMP AND BOND DRIVE
