Axmankaxaax He was picked up by the a FBI at 11pm the night of December 7,1941. He'd been with his family in Bellevue, when had dinner with them, then came home to Seattle. He was held in the Immigration Center on Dearborn Street or the County Jail from December 7, 1941 to April 1, 1942. The next month he moved into Puyallup Assembly Center with his family and the Japanese Americans of Seattle. One day he was given an hour and half to muk get his family and m belongings togehter to be moved to another m camp. Tule Lake. Nobody else went. He assumed he was the victim of an informer. He assumed the informer was a member ofk the JACL. Afterxthexmerxx When Tule Lake was Ena transformed into a segregant camp, the Siberia of the concentration camps,

he

he was restored to the Seattle Nikkei at Minidoka. There kEXMAGXEERFITE the camp administrator...he doesn't remember the name, and neither did I...talked him into working in the legal aid department, hEERMARE After the war he relocated to Sacramento then to LA. where the JACL hetpedxhimx giv gave him the name of a church group that ginxex gave him a place to stay til he got a grip on the Angel City. He gave generous contributions of two and three hundred dollars to the JACL and became a member. He was herr turned off by the E exclusivety of the "old guard"JACL and soon lost interest in attending meetingsex or other JACL activities. He is not now & a member of the JACL.
