Data: The work on the construction of showers in Block #4 of Area D has been in progress for approximately 12 days with a crew of 4 civilian employees under the supervision of the Army engineers.

Rate of progress is decidedly unsatisfactory.

As explicit evidence we offer the following.-- whereas a pipe threader is available to do the work efficiently in short order, workmen are resorting to hacksaws to cut up piping. Also the general attitude seems to point to a "stalling" proposition.

In the meantime the general population of Area D has been denied shower facilities and the situation is becoming serious.

Other facilities are available and only the completion of minor details will put this shower into operation.

We request pressure to be made on proper officials.

Confirming the result of the conference this morning, I am issuing the following procedure for the vote of confidence in the present Japanese administration. Forms are now being prepared by Headquarters for distribution to the areas for use in the vote of confidence poll to be conducted tomorrow (Tues.) night. The procedure will be as follows:

1. Area directors will instruct all checkers just prior to the time they go for the evening check up Tuesday night. Each checker will be accompanied by one first generation individual who will serve as a sort of certifying individual.
2. Checkers in the presence of this certifying individual will present the ballot form to all individuals in their particular districts 16 years of age or over and ask them to return and properly execute the form. Each checker will be provided beforehand with just enough forms for every eligible person in his particular district.
3. Each checker will be provided with a sealed box in which there is a slot which will be used to collect ballots. Ballot forms will be checked and tallied immediately after the poll is conducted by the checkers, certifying individuals, area director and the chief of the area police, and the result communicated to the Headquarters the following morning.
4. All individuals 16 years of age or older on June 1st, will be eligible to vote.
5. All ballots must, on the ballot form provided by H.Q. and distributed to checkers.
6. Improperly executed forms will be rejected.
7. All checkers and certifying individuals will be instructed that there will be no discussion of the pros and cons of the question at the time the ballot is presented and until the executed ballot is placed into the ballot box.
8. Those not wishing to vote will be instructed to place their ballots unmarked into the ballot box.

Area directors will submit the number of ballots required at the staff meeting tomorrow morning.



2. Information, bulletins, etc. from the W.C.C.A. Center Administration will flow through the Advisory Council to the Area Councils.
3. Suggestions, complaints and requests arising in the Area shall be directed to the Area Council who in turn will submit them to the Advisory Council for disposition through W.C.C.A. CENTER Administration. All matters which can be handled by the Area Council should not be submitted to the Advisory Council. The same procedure will hold true in respect to the Advisory Council in its relations with the W.C.C.A. Center Administration.
4. All requests for passes from the Area shall be directed to the Area Council, excepting:
 - (a) Employees whose work takes them to Areas other than their home Area.
 - (b) Programs, entertainment, etc. receiving prior approval.

Applications for passes accepted by the Area Council shall be submitted to W.C.C.A. Administration through the Advisory Council.

Subject: Procedure for the Operation of Laundry and Cleaning Facilities in Assembly Centers.

The following instructions are issued for the operation of laundry and cleaning services in Assembly Centers:

1. The laundry and cleaning facilities shall be under the management of the Service Division.
2. Sufficient space shall be provided in the Visitor's House to be used as a depository for outgoing and incoming laundry and cleaning items.
3. After consultation with the Center Japanese Council, local laundries and cleaning establishments shall be contacted by the Center Manager for the purpose of obtaining quotations for the various laundry and cleaning services required. Based on quotations received, a letter of acceptance shall be prepared and signed by the Center Japanese Council to notify the laundry and cleaning establishment selected to perform these services. The letter of acceptance shall not be a contract or an obligation to the Federal Government.
4. Through the Council a qualified evacuee shall be assigned to tally in and out bundles and packages. The evacuee family or individual desiring this service shall be required to retain a copy of the laundry or cleaning ticket.
5. Caucasian staff members or evacuees as agents shall be prohibited from the collection of cash pertaining to the subject facilities.
6. The Center Manager shall establish definite delivery and pick up days, preferably twice a week. The laundry and cleaning establishments selected shall be instructed in writing by the Center Manager of the scheduled days for these services, and that cash collections are to be made by their representatives of the day ~~and~~ of delivery; such collections to be made at the depository located in the Visitor's House.
7. Laundry and cleaning facilities shall be operated on a cash basis only.

8. Evacuees shall be instructed on the terms of this procedure through regular facilities provided therefor.

At one of the previous headquarter's meeting, I discussed with the Area Directors matters in reference to unemployment compensation which had been denied to the Japanese in view of the State Department's interpretation that we were unavailable for work due to curfew regulations and also due to travel restrictions. As discussed at that time, my Petition for Review has also been filed following my case which was presented as an appeal before the hearing tribunal.

My attorney now informs me by letter that he received the "Order of Commissioner" of the unemployment compensation division of the State of Washington affirming the previous ruling in this case.

I had inquired of my attorney whether my case may be considered as a test case for the Japanese and he has stated that the ruling in this case should apply to all Japanese whose situation is similar to that of mine--that is, those whose training and experience would qualify them for work available during regular business hours in areas in which they were free to travel. However, he feels that it would not apply to Japanese whose jobs were ordinarily not performed during hours covered by the curfew or performed in areas in which they were not permitted to travel. I discussed the later clause of this statement personally with my attorney at the time of his visit here, and he believed that if the person in question resided at the place of employment--that is, men for instance like night clerks--they would still qualify. Therefore, it will consider practically all cases that had been denied to the Japanese. However, if Japanese, whose compensation had been denied, did not file their "Notices of Appeal," he believed that the unemployment division may take advantage of the situation and deny the compensation. On the other hand, he believed that it is barely possible that should I be successful in my suit, the State Department may voluntarily pay the claims of Japanese who are in the same position as I although they had not appealed. However, he further states, "Frankly, however, I doubt that they would do this."

In view of the situation that exists following action taken upon my case, before I press any further for an appeal before the Superior Court, I shall appreciate your cooperation if you will immediately secure information for me as to how many claimants are entitled to their compensation and how many of such claimants have filed their "Notice of Appeal" following their receipt of rejection notices. Your immediate cooperation in this matter will be appreciated.


Gentlemen:

"Arrangements are now being prepared for the distribution of government-provided clothing to Center residents. Inasmuch as some of the work crews are in dire need of clothing, first requests for clothing will be received from individuals assigned to work crews with first priorities given to garbage crew and the kitchen crew. After these emergencies have been taken care of, applications will be taken from anyone who desires to request an issuance of clothing. Offices will be set up in each area for the taking of these applications. These office locations can be procured from the Information Service.

Clothing allowances are cumulative since date of residence in camp, and the total amount may be used when needed. Monthly clothing allowance per person is as follows:

Adult, male	\$3.82
Male, 6-18 years	2.15
Children, 1-5 years	2.60
Adult, female	4.61
Female, 6-18 years	2.85
Infant to 1 year	2.25

Each person and each family can from the above determine their present cumulative allowance since date of entry into the camp. Persons who came into camp, for instance, on the 15th of May and who would be entitled to \$3.82 per month, would have an allowance of 15/30 of \$3.82 for the month of May, \$3.82 for the month of June and \$3.82 for the month of July. The first orders taken will have to be purchased on an emergency basis with no chance for fittings. As a consequence, we would suggest the majority of clothing requests come in to the area office after we have an available stock to choose from in camp."






The alternative proposition submitted by the office involves the procurement of the equipment belonging to the Japanese shoemakers and stored in Seattle. Unless we take immediate advantage of this mood on the part of the WCCA, we will have lost a good opportunity.

Much as I hate to mention this fact, Mr. Edamura, foreman is negligent in his capacity in not being aggressive enough to push the requests for equipment or for the recruiting of additional experienced helpers. At present, the amount of work which has accumulated will require the services of all available help in Camp, but actually, the personnel, at present, include only 3 experienced shoemakers with 2 assistants who have had no previous experiences.

Please contact the WCCA Office and investigate the exact nature of their proposal in regard to the machinery which is needed immediately.
