Two lists with a total of 35 names of Topaz residents considered acceptable for selective service were received here from the Millard County Draft Board, February 10 and 11, it was announced. It was explained that the names were sent here to obtain the correct addresses of those named from the WRA.

"These menwill he called for pre-induction physical examinations as soon as their addresses are established and will be inducted as soon thereafter as time will permit. The local board will notify each one individually as soon as the examinations return to us," stated Millman Davies of the Millard County board.

The council's committee on selective service also announced that it has received the explanation that these men's records are already transferred from their local boards to the Millard County board by previous arrangement.

Names of persons on the list will be posted in each dining hall today. The story of evacuee relocation to the Eastern and Middlewestern states will be told to Topaz residents at two public meetings, tonight and Wednesday, at the auditorium by WRA field officers, Dr. P. A. Webber of Salt Lake City and Harold Fistere of Cleveland. They are members of the relocation team that is making a tour of all the centers. They arrived here Sunday,

In addition to these two meeting, Fisters and Dr. Webber are scheduled to speak before the council, block managers, office workers, Inter-Faith, and other groups during the week.
