places.

The apprenticeship training for nurses' aides which is being carried on at the hospital offers a golden opportunity to men and women to learn to care for the sick which will not only assist them while they are residents of Topaz but will help them to care for their families and friends at all times.

The responsibility for taking care of the sick should be of interest to all residents and it should be the duty of every leader in this community to advise a sufficient number of suitable persons to apply for the training so that residents who are unfortunate enough to be hospitalized will always receive the best nursing care.

The relatives and friends of the young men and women who are now working at the hospital should be proud of them as they are carrying out a noble work in their care of the sick.

This training has been a benefit to some who have relocated as they are now working as nurses' aides and attendants in some of the hospitals in various cities. The training also makes it possible to relocate as a child's nurse, and in some states as a practical nurse. Convalescent homes, children centers, as well as some hospitals would be caper to accept the services of attendants with they training and experience the Topaz Hospital gives to their attendants and nurses' aides.

Giles that the government took possession of the Topaz area, which includes 6700 acres of land acquired by the county on tax deed. The county gave the government an option to buy the land for \$1 per acre, but the ontion has not been exercised.
