CITIZEN QUESTIONS ANSWERED

The following are the exact questions lowing the citizens' meeting last Thursformulated by a committee of 15 resi- day night, and answered by the War Dedents selected at random by Tsune Baba, partment team headed by Lieutenant Wilchairman of the Community Council; fol- liam L. Tracy:

(1) Why Nisei segregation in the combat unit?

A. The organization of your men into a separate combat team is not segregation: It is the means of making the most effective use of your strength for the good of the national war effort and for the ulnese Americans. There will be other Japanese Americans taken into the Army and they will be assigned in the same way as any other American soldier. The organization of a separate Japanese American combat team has the distinct and very definite advantage and value of bringing the Japanese American question (8) Will any other to the attention of the American public and to establish their position as loyal American citizens.

The combat team is an exceptional organization. Others may be taken into the Army and will be given assignments on the same basis as other American soldiers.

(2) If we volunteer, will we have the choice of going into the Japanese Battalaon or any other?

A. No. The volunteers obtained here will go into the combat team which is an exceptional organization: Others may later be taken into the Army and will be given assignments on the same basis as other American soldiers.

(3) Will the draft follow this volunteering?

A. Yes

A. You will be given assignments on the same basis as other American soldiers.
