

RATION BOOK 3 FOR RESETTLERS

All evacuees leaving the center for re-relocation outside are advised by Mrs. Florence Mathiesen, head of the local rationing board, to apply for ration books number 3 as soon as they are settled. The procedures are as follows:

- 1) Go to the nearest Post Office and get an application for ration book No. 3.
- 2) Fill out as directed and return to the Post Office keeping the identification slip.
- 3) The ration book will be returned by mail from the state O.P.A. offices in the state in which the application is made.
- 4) These books will not be good until after September 1 as books issued before leaving the center contain enough ration stamps to last until then.

VEHICLES FOR PRIVATE USE PROHIBITED

Evacuees shall not have the custody or use of motor vehicles at the relocation centers for their own private purposes, except as specifically authorized in individual cases by the Project Director was stated by Dillon S. Myer in the Administrative Instruction No. 93.

It is also suggested to the Proj. Dir. that such specific authorization may be appropriated in individual cases in which the evacuee, about to depart from centers on leave, own or have lawful control over the motor vehicles for the purpose of removing personal belongings.

MOSQUITO INCREASE SEEN HERE

Residents of Poston mosquitos. By actual measurement, it was reported, that a majority of the blocks have been using as much as 15 gallons of water per minute, which are connected to the sewerage pool.

The waste water of coolers often are allowed to collect under barracks and offer a perfect set-up for the wregglers. These stagnant pools under barracks must be eliminated, stated Mr. Nishimoto. If waste water must run, residents are requested to make arrangements so it may run in the open in order that the danger of breeding may be seen and measures taken. All fish ponds must be stocked with minnows, to have carps & catfish is not enough as the people have a tendency to feed these.

FARMERS MAY LEAVE FOR EASTERN AREA

According to word received from Robert Dolins, Relocation Officer of the Eastern Defense Command, farmers in Poston, with Eastern Defense Command clearing may leave for Maryland, Delaware and Virginia without a job offer, the Outside Employment Dept. announced today. "We would be glad to accept anyone whom you wish to send directly to us (if they have eastern area clearance)," stated Mr. Dolins, "and we would help to place them after arrival."

Dolins also reported that literally hundreds of farm jobs were available with general prevailing wages in the area being \$50 a month with room and board. "We could place any of the people with farm experience whom you send into this area," he said, "Maryland and Delaware are exceedingly productive in the truck farming, poultry and orchard lines."

The Sanitation Dept. has been oiling small ditches around the blocks. A thin film of oil is all that is required to prevent breeding. Fire barrels must also be oiled. This must be done weekly. A small can of water left along for 10 days can be a source of torment to the whole block.

This system of concentrated living and congested quarters is an invitation to epidemic. Mosquitoes carry the virus of encephalitis (sleeping sickness) from fowl to human as well as malaria and other dangerous diseases. Residents are requested to cooperate with this campaign against mosquitoes.

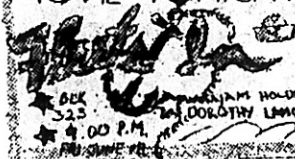
