1) Go to the nearest Post Office and get an application for ration book No. 3.

2) Fill out as direct and return to the Post Office keeping the identification slip.

3) The ration book will be returned by mail from the. 0.P.A. ofstate fices in the state in which the application is made.

4) These books will not be good until after September 1 as books issued before leaving the center contain enough ration stamps to last until then.


