

Treasury Department Unblocks All But Limited Number Of Evacuee Accounts On Army Clear List

WASHINGTON. — To aid WRA in its relocation and liquidation program, the Treasury Department has informed the WRA that they unblock all but a limited number of the accounts of evacuees on the Army clear list.

Through the Project Director, forms to request unblocking orders will be forwarded to the Federal Reserve Bank in San Francisco. The bank will determine whether the accounts of the individual forms are correct. Individual unblocking orders will be mailed in care of the Project Director, and private banks will be notified.

Evacuees in these categories are ineligible to apply for unblocking orders through this special arrangement with Treasury: (1) persons not on the Army clear list, (2) those who have been issued specific blocking orders, (3) evacuees who have represented or acted as agents for any person outside the continental United States on or since July 26, 1941, and (4) persons who now hold funds belonging to blocked nationals.

Those who are not eligible may, however, apply for reconsideration of their cases by filing Form TFD-1 with the Federal Reserve Bank of San Francisco. Business enterprises may apply for unblocking through the same procedure.

Unblocked persons and business enterprises are subject to the same procedures.

Rancher in Yuba Threatened for Hiring Japanese

MARYSVILLE (Yuba Co., Calif.). — Federal county and Camp Beale military authorities Thursday started hiring Japanese after Harvey B. Whitten, operator of a ranch employing Japanese Americans, complained to the officials he was threatened with violence by two men in armed service uniforms in Wheatland, Tuesday night.

The uniformed men, Whitten said, resented his hiring of recently released Japanese Americans on his Placer County ranch near Wheatland.

Whitten telephoned to W. E. (Bud) Urmon of Sacramento, representative of the WRA, who conferred with Sheriff Charles J. McCoy and representatives of the provost marshal's office at Camp Beale. Whitten said one of the men who threatened him was dressed as a marine and the other as a soldier.

Sheriff McCoy visited Wheatland to check information that the two lived in that vicinity.

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Report On Japanese Given Calif. Senate

SACRAMENTO. — A Senate interim committee on Japanese resettlement held before the Senate last week a report stating that the committee is vigorously opposed to the return of any Japanese to California before the end of the war.

The committee also recommends the most careful scrutiny of Japanese language schools if they should be reopened.

Sen. Donnelly, Turlock (D.), is chairman of the committee. Other members of which are Sen. Dorsey (R.), Bakerfield; Slater (D.), Santa Rosa; Quinn (D.), Eureka and Hatfield (R.), Merced County.

The report also states: "It is highly desirable that some means be found to eliminate or alleviate the condition in California resulting from the dual citizenship of Japanese, this being a means by which, while Japanese may have American citizenship, they in many cases place a higher value and a higher loyalty upon their Japanese citizenship."

"Unfortunately, this appears to be entirely a Federal question and a matter which is beyond the jurisdiction of the State of California."

Allen Law Law
Between 1943 and 1945 the committee held hearings at Modesto, Turlock, Merced, Watsonville, Salinas, Marysville, San Francisco, Los Angeles, and Tule Lake on Japanese resettlement.

The committee reports that it found the alien law had not been properly enforced in California at any time since its adoption in 1913.

The Federal Government, which opposed the law at the outset, has been against ever since. The committee states, and this has made enforcement difficult.

Gov. Warren signed legislation last Wednesday designed to remove constitutional objections to a California law prohibiting the issuance of commercial fishing licenses to alien Japanese.

Members of the committee are ineligible for citizenship because of their Japanese citizenship.

War and Navy Depts. to Extend 'Sole Surviving Son' Policy

WASHINGTON. — In a joint extension of their "sole surviving son" policy, the War and Navy Departments have announced that they will place in non-hazardous duty other service members of families in which two or more persons have died in line of duty or are reported missing in action or prisoners of war.

War and Navy Department officials estimate that the new policy will affect approximately 10,000 individuals in both services. They stated that no action to resign surviving members will be taken unless requested by the servicemen involved or by a member of his immediate family.

Requests involving Army personnel should be addressed to the Adjutant General, Washington, D. C. Cases which previously have been submitted and denied should be resubmitted for consideration under the new, broader policy, the joint statement advised.

Casualties considered under the new plan will include servicemen who have been killed, died as a result of wounds, accident or disease, or have been reported missing or prisoners.

Non-hazardous duty may mean reports 50 Japanese returned to Oregon homes since the report of May 1944 when 167 had returned here.

Measures to Aid Resettling Evacuees Outlined

WASHINGTON. — Extraordinary measures to assist resettling evacuees in finding housing have been outlined by H. Rex Lee, Relocation Division Chief, in instructions sent to all Field Relocation Offices.

To further this effort, Mr. Lee said, a WRA staff member will be assigned in most large offices the specific responsibility of organizing community efforts to develop housing for resettling evacuees.

Other principal steps to be taken include:

(1) Establishment of a clearing house for all available housing information, either as a part of the community activities program to assist resettlers or as a
