Aurnburn Baptists To Aid Sakamoto

ABURN, Calif.—The Auburn Baptist Church has undertaken a drive to supply additional funds for the reconstruction of a dwelling near Losimos, belonging to Cosme Sakamoto, a Japanese American soldier. The home was destroyed by fire last month on the eve of the return of Mr. and Mrs. K. Sakamoto, parents of the soldier, from a relocation camp.

The Rev. G. E. Harris, pastor of the church, stated a free will offering will be made at the church during morning services on Nov. 4.

"The offering will be made in a gesture of sympathy and appreciation toward the Japanese American family," said Rev. Harris. "Four sons of the family served the armed forces, losing his life."

"It will also serve as a sign of protest by church people against lawless forces operating in this area."

Race Accord Board Idea Starts Argument

LOS ANGELES—A controversy of major proportion appeared to be brewing in the City Council this week over proposals that a city ordinance be passed creating a so-called Community Relations Board to promote amicable relations among racial and cultural groups, an providing \$20,000 or more to finance its operations.

When the measure first appeared as a motion to instruct the City Attorney to draw up the ordinance, it promptly drew fire from Councilman Lloyd Davies and there were indications that there would be other dissenters.

"This thing will create more riots and race discrimination than it would do good," asserted Davies.

Councilman Ed Davenport, however, was just as fervent in his support of the interracial group. He stated that at a luncheon given by the sponsors of the ACLU and the CIO (men) practically committed ourselves in favor of it."

It was finally decided to hold a public hearing on the matter before the Council on Oct. 31.

WRA To Leave Tule By Feb. 1st

WASHINGTON—The War Relocation Authority is preparing for the departure of Japanese from the Tule Lake Center in northern California, following unanimous action taken by all members present at a meeting last week.

With this step, the WRA will complete its schedule for liquidating its operations at the last of the ten centers which were established in 1942 to accommodate the people of Japanese ancestry evacuated by military order from the Pacific Coast.

Two of the centers, Jerome in Arkansas and Granada in Colorado, have already been closed. All the other except Tule Lake will be closed by Dec. 15 in accordance with plans previously announced.

During the few months of operations and about at the Tule Lake center, the WRA will continue to assist in the relocation of those residents who are eligible to leave. Those who are not eligible to leave because they are under detention orders issued by the Department of Justice will remain in the custody of that department pending final disposition of their cases.

Nisei Seek Liquor Licenses In Sacramento

SACRAMENTO—Officials of the State Board of Equalization this week revealed several Japanese Americans, including a number of veterans of World War II, have applied for the restoration of distilled spirits licenses they held before the war.

An attorney for the board said there appears to be no legal way the licenses can be regained. The licensee served a short term in Pearl Harbor, he said, and meanwhile a limitation law on hard liquor permits precludes the issuance of new licenses.

Only where a veteran voluntarily surrendered his license for the duration can the board restore it, the counsel explained.


