

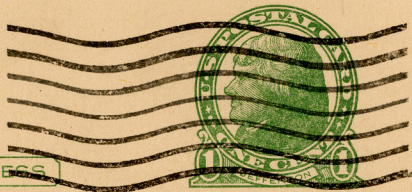
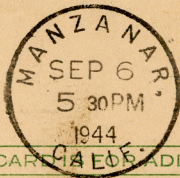
Hi Joe + Tor, Sept. 4, 1944

wanted back for work +
friendship. We are staying
here till L.A. is opened to
us. Again. Well, out of
