WAREHOUSE TO BE CONVERTED INTO OFFICES

For the convenience of evacuees, an office converted from a warehouse will be erected on the fence line opposite the Internal Security Building near the turnstile gates to house the farm office; the evacuee property office, as well as the branch office at 1608-A; and the supervisor's office of the business enterprise, stated Paul Robertson, assistant project director in charge of Operations.

This building will have an entrance from the colony side for the benefit of the residents. Construction will begin sometime this week, he added.

HIGH SCHOOL PURCHASES CO-OP MOVIE EQUIPMENT

The long-awaited establishment of the colony movie theater was finally realized with the announcement made by Kenneth Harkness, superintendent of Education, that Tri-State High School Student Association has purchased the 35mm moving picture equipment already installed in the auditorium from the Community Enterprises to show pictures on Saturdays.

"Lady in the Dark" starring Ginger Rogers and Ray Milland will be the first movie to be shown under the new set-up this Saturday. Showings will begin at 1 p.m., 3:15 p.m. and 7 p.m.

Tickets will be on sale at the auditorium ticket booth tomorrow from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. and on Saturday morning from 10:30. The admission price of 10 cents will be charged to children and adults alike. Patrons are urged to bring exact change for purchasing tickets and are asked to attend the performance as specified by the ticket.

RENUNCIATION QUERIES ON PROCEDURE ANSWERED BY BURLING

John L. Burling, Department of Justice official, here conducting renunciation of citizenship hearings, today issued to the NEWELL STAR, since he would not have time to talk to all persons individually, the following answers to questions he had received.

Q. Can residents of relocation centers, other than Tule Lake, apply to renounce their citizenship?

A. Yes. The law makes no reference to Tule Lake nor to persons of Japanese ancestry. Any citizen of any ancestry, whether he is a citizen by birth, derivation or naturalization, may, if he chooses, apply for permission to renounce his citizenship.

Q. What should persons who sent application forms

copied on the typewriter now do?

A. If I am able to interview them individually before leaving the project, I will give them the correct forms. Otherwise, it would be quickest to write to the Attorney General, Department of Justice, Washington 25, D. C., and ask for the correct forms. It will be impossible for me to see all the people who filed applications on the wrong form at this time.

Q. What should persons who have written the Attorney General asking for the forms, but who have not received them, now do?

A. If several persons signed a petition or joint letter asking for the forms, they should now write again, separately, and ask for the forms, since the regulations require each person to request the forms individually. If, however, they have written individual letters asking for the forms, they should wait. The forms will arrive in due course.

Q. What should persons who have filled in the proper form of application now do?

A. The application should be mailed back to the Attorney General in Washington. A hearing will then be scheduled at the project as soon as possible and they will be notified of the date.

IMMIGRATION OFFICER TO WRA NOTICE TO ARRIVE HERE NEXT WEEK ALL WORKERS

Project Attorney Louis Noyes reminded the residents today that Harmon Hosier, Immigration and Naturalization Service officer, will visit this center on Dec. 20 and 21.

Japanese nationals who have gone to the project attorney's office for duplicate alien registration receipt cards, duplicate certificates of identification, or who have attained the age of 14 since being

registered under the 1940 Alien Registration Act, will receive a personal letter through the mail to inform them of their appointment time with Mr. Hosier.

Those Japanese nationals who have not made preliminary arrangements with the project attorney's office in the Administration Building are urged to do so by next Tuesday.

The Administration recently announced that evacuee appointees are subject to respond and assume any duty assigned in cases of accidents, fires, or emergency duty not in job description.

This action, the Administration asserted, will afford protection for employees in the event of injuries, insofar as they are not entitled to the benefits of the U. S. Employees Compensation Act while performing duties outside of their regular assignments.

COST OF BREAD DOWN - HAYWARD

Raymond Hayward, chief project steward, reported this week that the cost of bread produced by the project bakery during November was \$.039 per pound. This is a saving of more than 3 cents per pound in comparison with bread purchased from the outside at 7 cents a pound, he said.

application forms from you?

A. No. It is necessary to write to the Attorney General in Washington.

Q. When will the next hearings be scheduled?

A. This cannot be stated definitely at the present time, but additional hearings will be scheduled as soon as possible. In the meantime, the best way to secure a prompt hearing will be to follow the regulations carefully. No requests for special hearings for residents can be granted.

Q. When does renunciation become effective?

A. After the final renunciation is signed it will be considered by the Attorney General. The applicant will be notified of the Attorney General's decision. If the Attorney General approves the renunciation as not contrary to the interests of national defense it becomes effective immediately.
