A. No. It is necessary to write to the Attorney General in Washington.

Q. When will the next hearings be scheduled?

A. This cannot be stated definitely at the present time; but additional hearings will be scheduled as soon as possible. In the meantime, the best way to secure a prompt hearing will be to follow the regulations carefully. No requests for special hearings for residents can be granted.

Q. When does renuncia-tion become effective?

A. After the final renunciation is signed it will be considered by the Attorney General. The applicant will be notified of the Attorney General's decision. If the Attorney General approves the renunciation as not contrary to the interests of national defense it becomes effective immediately.
