Dear Miss Nimura:

In reply to your letter of March 9, 1943 we wish to inform you that your father is presently at the Sharp Park Detention Camp, Sharp Park, California and your mail should be addressed to him at that place. It is permissible to send him the necessities which you mentioned in your letter.

Wednesday, March 17, 1943 has been set as the date for your father's hearing before the Alien Enemy Hearing Board. The matter will then be presented to the Attorney General, Washington, D. C., and pending his decision your father will be detained at Sharp Park.





Apparently Hisa's father was quite vocal about being there and became known as a "troublemaker" so he was sent off to another camp after a hearing at Sharp Park Detention Camp, Sharp Park, Ca. His hearing was on Mar.17, 1943 and he was sent on to Sante Fe, New Mexico. Hisa would not see him for a number of years. This left Hisa's Mom with the children at Tule Lake for most of their time there. Note postcard from Hisa's Father.
