


## Parent-Child Journal Origami Storyteller



#### **ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Color and cut out your storyteller.
- 2. Flip over so story side faces down.
- 3. Crease in half diagonally.
- 4. Crease in half on the other diagonal.
- 5. Fold in all four corners to center point.
- 5. Flip over and fold in all new corners to center point.
- 5. Crease in half rectangularly, both ways.
- 6. Open pockets and insert a thumb or index finger in each under-flap.
- 7. Play together!


#### **PLAY GUIDELINES**

- 1. Insert a thumb or index finger in each underflap and pinch together.
- 2. Ask your partner to pick a color.
- 3. Spell the color three times while simultaneously spreading your fingers to reveal the numbers—thumbs together/index fingers together for the first letter, then left fingers together/right fingers together for the next. Back and forth.
- 4. Freeze fingers in the final position, revealing four numbers.
- 5. Ask your partner to pick a number. Repeat step three, this time counting the selected number.
- $\ensuremath{\mathsf{6}}.$  Freeze fingers in the final position, and ask your partner to pick a number.
- 7. Open the flap and reveal your question. Ask your partner for the story!


### **PLAY GUIDELINES**
