





#### What sort of a gift is Jesus?


Jesus saves us from a life like the rich fool who can't get enough and from the fear and worry of not having enough.

Luke 12:14-15



Luke 12:16-19


<sup>16</sup> The ground of a certain rich man yielded an abundant harvest.


#### Saved From Greeds Grip & Worry's Fear
