Bible reading: Psalm 148

Big Idea: Everything made is called to praise the Lord.

- i. Last 5 Psalms start and end with Praise the Lord.
- ii. Intentional ending of the Psalter = rich theology leads to wonderful praise.
- iii. Psalm 148 widest scope of praise in the Psalter.

Praise is like... advertising?

- i. Proclaim and tell of how good and valuable something is.
- ii. Praise = set a price. Find value and joy in God so praise him.

Praise the Lord from the skies (Psalm 148:1-6)

Creation exists to praise God.

Look at all there is, but praise of God, not them.

Praise the Lord from the land (Psalm 148:7-14)

What's with the Horn?

- i. Bulls' Horn raised after battle = strength and victory.
- ii. See 1 Samuel 2, Psalm 89:24, Luke 1:68-69. Messiah's victory for his people.

Praise the Lord with all you are

- i. Praise God by living according to his command.
- ii. Praise God for his salvation in Jesus.
