Bible reading: James 4:1-12

Big Idea: Submit to God – in your speech, your prayer, and your desires.

1. **Owning** our Conflict Within (James 4:1-6)

“But he gives us more grace.”

Our desires create war within—and with others.

Prayer becomes selfish when shaped by self.

God gives grace to the humble.

2. **Coming** to God Humbly (James 4:7-10)

“Humble yourselves before the Lord and he will lift you up.”

Submit to God.

Resist the devil.

Lament sin and turn to God.

3. **Showing** it in our speech (James 4:11-12)

“Who are you to judge your neighbour?”

Slander reveals a proud heart.

Submission to God shapes our speech.

Implication: The painful, but freeing need to submit to God.

“But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all sin.” 1 John 1:7.
