FINANCIAL PARTNERSHIP UPDATE (December 2025)

I'd like to once more express my profound thankfulness to God for the gospel generosity of our church family. This year's budget called for an 8% increase in congregational giving in order to balance our budget (we had been in deficit ever since sending 150 members to 3 new church plants in 2022). As 2025 wraps up, we remain on track to finish slightly in the black!

Whatever happens with the site redevelopment in 2026, our ongoing mission to make disciples of all nations will be unchanged. For that reason, **next year's budget will increase by a modest 5%**: partly due to inflation; but mostly so we can bring on **2 new Ministry Apprentices** to be trained and equipped for a lifetime of leading God's people.
