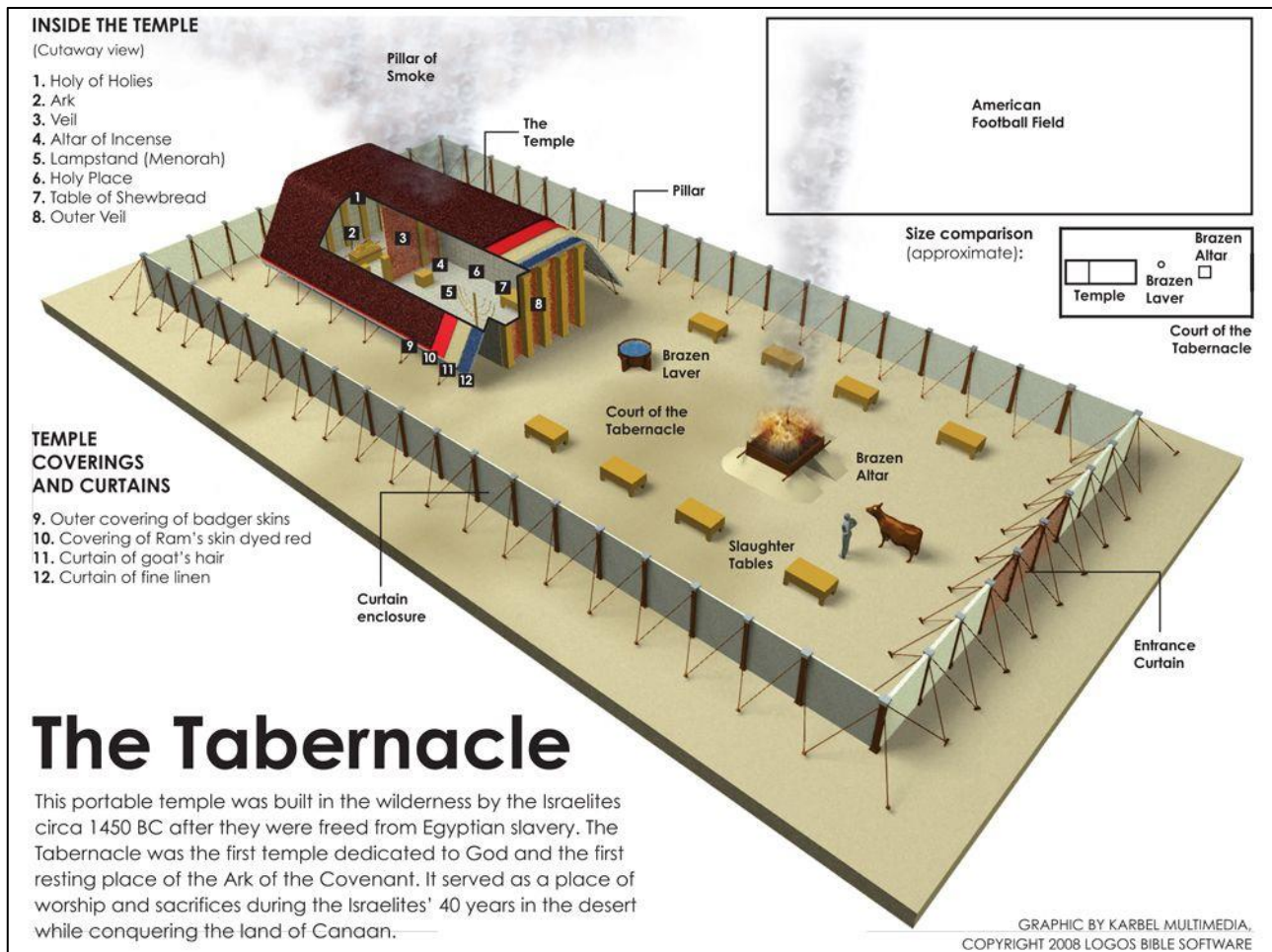


**Hebrews 9**

| v6 – priests        | (noun)      | people who offered sacrifices and prayers for people at the temple |
| v6 – ministry       | (noun)      | service to God   |
| v7 – sins           | (noun)      | rejection of God; rebellion against God                            |
| v7 – ‘in ignorance’ |             | without knowing  |
| v8 – disclosed      | (verb)      | told people about something that up till now has been hidden       |
| v9 – conscience     | (noun)      | inner sense of right and wrong                                     |
| v10 – external      | (adjective) | applying to the outside appearance only                            |
| v10 – order         | (noun)      | the way a system is organised or structured                        |
| v12 – goats         | (noun)      |  |

| v12 – calves    | (noun) | young cows         |
| v12 – obtaining | (verb) | achieving; gaining |

v12 – eternal	(adjective)	everlasting; does not end
v12 – redemption	(noun)	the act of paying a price to get something back
v13 – ashes	(noun)	the grey/black powder that is left after something is burnt
v13 – heifer	(noun)	a young female cow that has not yet had a calf
v13 – sprinkled	(verb)	scattered; distributed over an area
v13 – sanctify	(verb)	make holy; make perfect; set apart for God’s purpose
v14 – unblemished	(adjective)	without any imperfections
v15 – mediator	(noun)	someone who helps a process to happen
v15 – covenant	(noun)	a formal agreement between two parties outlining their responsibilities to each other
v15 – inheritance	(noun)	property you receive from someone when they die
v15 – ransom	(noun)	money paid to set someone free from their captors
v18 – ‘put into effect’		carry out a plan; cause something to happen
v19 – scarlet	(adjective)	red
v19 – hyssop	(noun)	a kind of plant used in Israel’s religious ceremonies for sprinkling blood



v19 – scroll	(noun)	a rolled piece of parchment that had writing on it. In this case, God’s law for Israel was written on it.

v22 – ‘shedding of blood’		death
v22 – forgiveness	(noun)	the action of no longer being angry with someone or wanting to punish them for the wrong they have done.
v23 – purified	(verb)	made perfect; made clean; made to be without any dirty or inferior substances
v23 – sacrifices	(noun)	animals that were killed and offered to God as an act of worship
v24 – sanctuary	(noun)	a religious place
v26 – culmination	(noun)	the high point or conclusion of a series of events
v27 – destined	(adjective)	certain; happened according to a pre-existing plan
v28 – salvation	(noun)	the act of saving someone from danger; the act of God saving people from our sins
