WHY MIGHT YOU WANT TO MEET JESUS? – Part 1

1. He is still in control ... (18:1-14)

2. He rises above the behaviour of His followers (18:15-27)

3. His kingdom is not of this world (18:28-19:16a)

4. His death changes lives (19:16b-42)

Jn 19:28 Later, knowing that *everything had now been finished* ...

Jn 19:30 When he had received the drink, Jesus said, "*It is finished.*" With that, he bowed his head and gave up his spirit.

Jn 10:11 I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep.

Jn 1:29 The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, "Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!

=> Barabbas

=> Joseph of Arimathea - "a disciple of Jesus, but secretly" (v38)

=> Nicodemus the Pharisee - "who earlier had visited Jesus at night" (v39)

=> Simon Peter

=> ???
