Acts 4:31 Filled with the Holy spirit AND spoke the word of God boldly (Acts 4:8ff)

Acts 13:9 -10 Paul is filled with the Holy Spirit AND rebukes Elymas

Full of the Spirit AND...a characteristic

Acts 6:3 Full of the Spirit AND wisdom

Acts 6:5 Full of the Holy Spirit AND faith

Acts 11:24 Full of the Holy Spirit AND faith

- Examples not a command
