Bible Reading: Joshua 1:1-18

Jos 1:1 After the death of Moses the servant of the LORD ...

- Deut 34:10 Since then, no prophet has risen in Israel like Moses, whom the LORD knew face to face

Ex 33:11 The LORD would speak to Moses face to face, as one speaks to a friend

### 1. What God is going to do (vv2-5)

- we belong to a bigger and better story ...

Gen 12:1 The LORD had said to Abram, "Go from your country, your people and your father's household to the land I will show you. 2 "I will make you into a great nation, and I will bless you; I will make your name great, and you will be a blessing. 3 I will bless those who bless you, and whoever curses you I will curse; and all peoples on earth will be blessed through you."

# 2. What Joshua is meant to do (vv6-11)

"Be strong and courageous" (v6, v7, v9; cf Deut 31:1-8)

- i. (v6) because God already swore to give the land to their ancestors
- ii. (v7) because God Himself will show them how to live
- iii. (v9) because God will be with them wherever they will go/whatever they face
- Deep Dive (730-9pm, Thu Sept 5) on "Holy War in the OT"
- Joshua is to live by God's PROMISES and according to God's WORD

## 3. What the Israelites say they will do (vv12-18)

- Numbers 32 (the Transjordanian tribes: the Reubenites, Gadites, half-tribe of Manasseh)
- "Just as we fully obeyed Moses, so we will obey you ..." (v17)

#### So what, for us?

### i. God's promises are trustworthy

### ii. God's word is our authority

- Joshua 23:6
- Be Like the Bereans (Acts 17:11)
- Ez 11:19 I will give them an undivided heart and put a new spirit in them; I will remove from them their heart of stone and give them a heart of flesh. 20 Then they will follow my decrees and be careful to keep my laws. They will be my people, and I will be their God.

2 practical ways God's word is written on our hearts:

- i. ongoing meditation
- ii. intentional memorization

Jos 1:8 Keep this Book of the Law always on your lips; meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. Then you will be prosperous and successful.

## iii. Looking for a new Joshua for today

Mt 1:21 She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name **Jesus** [Gk. "Joshua" = "God saves"], because he will save his people from their sins"
