Ecc 1:2 "Meaningless! Meaningless!" says the Teacher. "Utterly meaningless! Everything is meaningless."

- "meaningless" = fleeting/fading/passing away ≠ futile/pointless/worthless

1 Tim 6:19 In this way they will lay up treasure for themselves as a firm foundation for the coming age, so that they may take hold of the life that is truly life.

1. Learning how to tell the time (3:1-8)

i. Identify the season you're currently in

ii. Accept you can't do everything all the time

- YOLO: You Only Live Once

- FOMO: Fear Of Missing Out

2. Listening to what God says about time ... (3:9-22)

v10: "I have seen the burden God has laid on the human race"

v11a: "He has made everything beautiful in its time"

- lift us up and weigh us down

1 Tim 4:1 The Spirit clearly says that in later times some will abandon the faith and follow deceiving spirits and things taught by demons. 2 Such teachings come through hypocritical liars, whose consciences have been seared as with a hot iron. 3 They forbid people to marry and order them to abstain from certain foods, which God created to be received with thanksgiving by those who believe and who know the truth. <u>4 For everything God created is good, and nothing is to be rejected if it is received with thanksgiving</u>, 5 because it is consecrated by the word of God and prayer.

- Christians are not ANTI-creation but neither are we ONLY-creation v11b: "He has also set eternity in the human heart; yet no one can fathom what God has done from beginning to end"

- Augustine: "You have made us for yourself, O Lord, and our hearts are restless until they rest in You"

3. Living with God's perspective of time

i. Repent while there is time

- "superintendence"

2 Pet 3:8 But do not forget this one thing, dear friends: With the Lord a day is like a thousand years, and a thousand years are like a day. 9 The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness. Instead he is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance.

- Explore (starts Nov 24)

ii. See the good in every season
