Name the 3 most important Christian priorities

Here is a trustworthy saying

1 Timothy 1:15

¹⁵ Here is a trustworthy saying that deserves full acceptance: Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners—of whom I am the worst.

1 Timothy 4:9-10

⁹ This is a trustworthy saying that deserves full acceptance. ¹⁰ That is why we labor and strive, because we have put our hope in the living God, who is the Savior of all people, and especially of those who believe.

1 Timothy 3:1

¹ Here is a trustworthy saying: Whoever aspires to be an overseer desires a noble task.

Why is leadership in God's church so important?

- 1. In Search of the Perfect Leadership Structure
- Overseers, bishops, elders, deacons...
- The emphasis is not on their job descriptions but who they ARE.
- 2. Character is Paramount
- A culture in love with externals/image
- a. Able to teach (v2)
- 1 Timothy 1:3,7; 4:2.
- b. How has the gospel shaped the leader's life?

True doctrine leads to Godly living But not perfection (1 Timothy 5:20)

Deep care for those around them Hospitable

Self-control (not a drunk or violent)

Healthy household V3 faithful to his wife

V4 (v 12) Manage his own family well and see that his children obey him

Nb Titus 1:6 An elder must be...a man whose children believe

Not a lover of money (v3)

A good reputation with outsiders (v7)

V10 nothing against them (literally blameless)
