5 "Rs" for reading Mark 1-2-1 ...

- 1. Retell: Retell the episode in your own words
- 2. React: How do people react to Jesus?
- 3. Reveal: What is revealed about Jesus?
- 4. Reason: What reason might Mark have for including this episode?
- 5. Respond: What does Mark teach us about how to respond to Jesus?
- 1. Retell: Retell the episode in your own words
- a young boy afflicted with almost inconceivable suffering

Mk 5:2 When Jesus got out of the boat, a man with an impure spirit came from the tombs to meet him. 3 This man lived in the tombs, and no one could bind him anymore, not even with a chain.

- Q. Who is this "unbelieving generation"?
- "If you can do anything, take pity on us (lit. "have compassion") and help us" (Mk 9:22)

Mk 6:34 When Jesus landed and saw a large crowd, he **had compassion** on them, because they were like sheep without a shepherd ...

Mk 8:2 "I have compassion for these people; they have already been with me three days and have nothing to eat."

- "I do believe; help me overcome my unbelief!" (Mk 9:24)
- "the boy looked so much like a corpse that many said, "He's dead"" (Mk 9:26b)
 - cf Mk 5: the man in the tombs was "as good as dead/the living dead"; the woman who'd been bleeding for 12 years was "spiritually dead"; Jarius the synagogue ruler's 12 year old daughter was actually dead ...
- "lifted him to his feet" (lit. "raised him") (Mk 9:27)

Mk 16:6 "Don't be alarmed," he said. "You are looking for Jesus the Nazarene, who was crucified. He has **risen**! He is not here. See the place where they laid him."

Mk 6:13 They drove out many demons and anointed many sick people with oil and healed them.

Q. What does "this kind can come out only by prayer" mean?

Mk 11:18 The chief priests and the teachers of the law heard this and began looking for a way to kill him, for they feared him, because the whole crowd was amazed at his teaching.

 - i. 2 Cor 5:7 For we live by faith, not by sight.

Mt 17:20 He replied, "Because you have so little faith. Truly I tell you, if you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move. Nothing will be impossible for you."
