
### 1. Via Electronic Bank Transfer

You will need to complete the [Appeal Donation Form](#), send it to the National Trust and send the money using the bank details on the form.

### 2. Online using your credit or debit card

**Step 1:** Click on the following link: [Appeals – National Trust of South Australia](#)


**Step 2:** Enter the amount you wish to give.
